

SAT School Day Parental Exception Waiver

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your teen will have the opportunity to take the SAT college entrance examination during the regular school day. The SAT, which is accepted at all U.S. colleges, measures what students are learning in high school and what they need to know to succeed in college and career. Taking the SAT exam during the school day can increase students' access to college, address barriers that hinder students from taking the exam, and reduce testing stress, e.g., eliminating financial hardship in paying for the exam, taking the test in a more familiar environment.

Eagle Rock Junior/Senior High School's SAT School Day administration, which is at no cost to juniors (Class of 2020) is scheduled on Tuesday, April 9th. However, you as a parent have the right to request that your teen not participate in this test administration by completing the form below and submitting it to our College and Career Counselor, Ms. Mena.
