Requirements: 2.0 GPA **▲**A-Gs, SAT and/or ACT.

No essays or letters of recommendations

Application Deadline: October 1- November 30

Admissions Decisions: Jan- March

- Begin and complete application online
- Send SAT and ACT scores: Send scores to one CSU only use code 3594.
- Complete EOP application. You will need two recommenders.
- Create and check portal after submitting application
- Submit Transcripts after 7th semester in January **if required** (Request from College Center).
- Register for EPT/ELM assessment exams no later than March unless exempt.

Requirements: 3.0 GPA **▲** A-Gs, SAT reasoning or ACT w/ writing portion,

No letters of recommendation (**Berkeley only if requested**). SAT subject tests recommended.

Deadlines: August 1- November 30

Admissions Decisions: March

- Begin and complete application online
- Begin and complete Personal Insight Questions 4 out of the 8. (350 words each question).
- Take Writing Assessment exam in May unless exempt.

Private/Independent Colleges

DO YOUR RESEARCH!!

Requirements: Vary, but similar to UC requirements
Essays and letters of recommendations maybe required.

Deadlines: December to January

Admissions Decisions: March- April

- Determine what application will be needed by the university. Most use Common App others may use the Universal App or their individual website.
- Determine if you will be applying Early action/ decision (October/ November Deadlines) or Regular application.
- Link Common App to Naviance
- Complete FERPA Waiver
- Request Teacher Recommendations on Naviance no later than Nov. 1st
- Begin and Complete application online. Some schools will request Supplemental materials.
- Brag Sheets are due to Ms. Mena by Nov. 1st. No excuses.

Community College (CC)

Requirements: Graduate high school or be older than 18. Must complete the following steps.

- Admissions application
- Online orientation
- English and math placement tests
- Appointment with a counselor (at the CC) to complete an individual education plan
- Register for courses

Deadlines: No specific deadline. Application is available after January. Priority Registration is given to students completing application process by April.

- NEW! Apply online between OCTOBER 1 – **Absolute deadline: March 2**
 - Use prior prior year taxes...meaning 2016 taxes.
- Private schools may require CSS Profile
 - <https://student.collegeboard.org/css-financial-aid-profile>
 - Some deadlines as early as January 30th.
- Apply to scholarships then apply to more.

Other

- Submit Intent to Register by May 1st. This notifies schools that you have accepted their offer to attend.
- Submit Final Transcript request
- Complete Senior survey on Naviance
- Indicate on Naviance what college you will be attending and update college list status.
