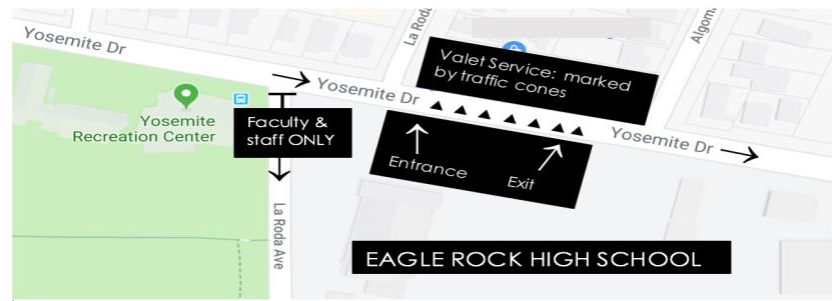

Dear Eagle Rock Junior/Senior Community:

We will be piloting an Eagles Valet drop-off program from **May 1-June 1, 2018** from **7:30am-8:00am** on Yosemite Boulevard. Entrance to La Roda will be limited during that time to faculty/staff with ERJSHS parking passes, visitors with preferred passes, disabled placards/plates and school busses. Student safety is paramount and some driving behaviors, coupled with drastic traffic, have necessitated us to collect data in order to maintain safe passage to our school. We will make a plan to include Oak Grove next year. We thank the City of Los Angeles' City Attorney, Department of Transportation, LAUSD School Police, and our Local School Leadership Council for this partnership.



- The valet zone on Yosemite Drive (west of La Roda) will be marked by orange cones. The valet zone starts at the western “No Parking Sign” and ends at the eastern “No Parking Sign” (adjacent to the red zone).
- Follow the traffic lights and keep the crosswalk clear.
- Reduce speed as you enter the valet lane separated by the cones and wait in line.
- Proceed to the front of the line.
- Enter traffic cautiously. **NO U-turns** in the school zone.
- *NOTE: Please do not park in the valet zone.*

For Yosemite **and** Oak Grove,

- Make sure lunches/lunch money, backpacks, instruments, athletic equipment, and other items are with your student(s). Avoid stopping to open the trunk.
- Have student(s) exit on the sidewalk side of street, *from passenger's side of the car ONLY.*

Please contact us if you have any questions, suggestions or concerns regarding the Pilot Valet Drop-off.
