Hello Seniors and Parents of Seniors,

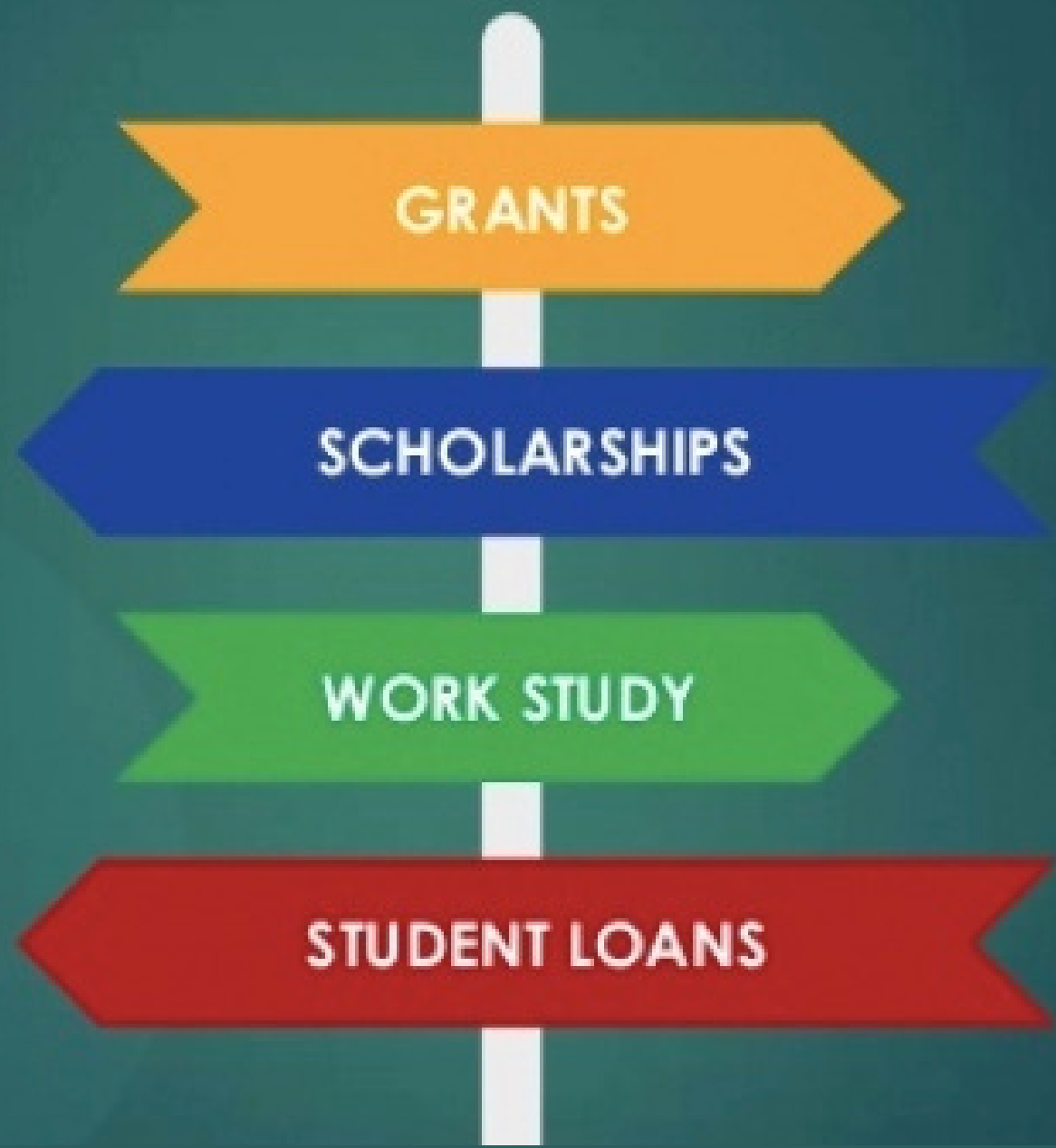
LAUSD Local District Central (LDC) and the Division of Instruction (DOI) are each holding workshops for students and families where you can receive personalized, one-to-one assistance with completing your **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** and **California Dream Act Application (CADAA)**. Remember, the applications for financial are due on **March 2nd**, so this is an incredible opportunity for you to complete the application appropriate to your circumstances with guidance from experts in these fields well in advance of the aforementioned deadline!

Most college decisions are predicated on your financial aid award amounts, so if you've not already undertaken this process, please do so by again, taking advantage of the chance to have your financial aid finished prior in a timely manner prior to **March 2nd**. 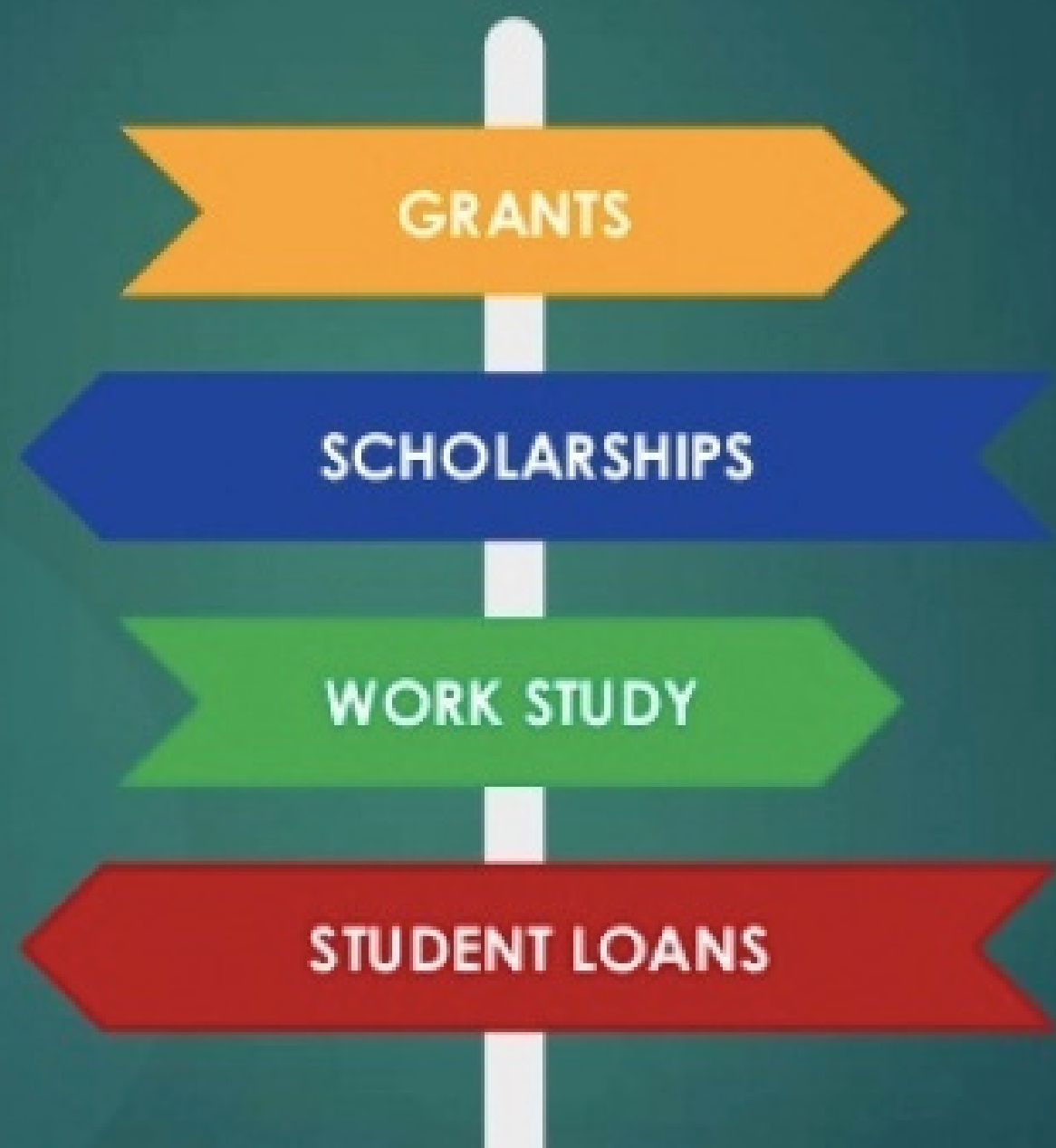
