



UC Berkeley ROAR Academy Program for Python Programming and Machine Learning - Offered Online in July and August 2021

The Vive Center's new ROAR Academy Summer program is a rigorous, intensive **two-week summer program** for advanced high school students (9-12) who have demonstrated an aptitude for academic and professional careers in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) subjects.

The goal of the academy is to support high school students in their exploration of engineering as a career path and to provide an in-depth and interactive overview of engineering majors, programming, hardware and software design, and allow students to use this experience in college applications. Students will be invited to race their autonomous driving agents and compete in 2021 Summer ROAR Competition.
