

BEYOND THE BELL SUMMER ENRICHMENT PROGRAM

Beyond the Bell will be offering a summer program at your school site from June 14, 2021 through July 30, 2021 (closed on July 5th) from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. This program is available for LAUSD students in grades TK-8.

In order for a child to be approved to participate, the Before and After-School Program Application/Agreement for the summer program must be completed. Once approved by Beyond the Bell staff, the child may participate.

Acknowledgement:

I agree to the following rules and guidelines for my child to be eligible to participate in the Beyond the Bell Summer Enrichment Program:

- My child is enrolled in LAUSD and in grades TK through 8.
- My child will be signed in and out from the designated supervised area of the program.
- I understand that priority is given to children who need the program from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday – Friday.
- I understand that the application does not guarantee enrollment. Space is limited and on a first come first served basis.
- My child has been instructed by me to go directly to the supervised area while participating in this program.
- My child has been informed and instructed by me that they may not leave the program unless they are signed out by me or an authorized adult. I understand that once my child is signed out of the program, they may not return for the remainder of the day.
- I understand that if my child does not get picked up by an authorized adult prior to the 6:00 p.m. closing time, staff will initiate late child procedures: at the conclusion of one hour of unsuccessful attempts to contact and reunite the child with the parent/designee, a child protective services agency is contacted to assume responsibility for the supervision and safety of the child.
- I understand that participation in this program is a privilege and failure by my child to abide by all rules may result in the loss of this privilege.
- I have provided more than one contact number and the names of additional adults that are authorized to pick up my child in case of an emergency, or to be reached in the event late child procedures are initiated. The designated adult must show a photo identification before a student is released to the designated adult.
- I hereby agree to indemnify, defend, release and hold harmless the Los Angeles Unified School District, its Board of Education and its authorized representatives from any and all actions, claims, damages, costs, or expenses, including attorney's fees, brought by the pupil and/or parent or guardian which relate to or arise out of this consent form and the activities and services provide through the Beyond the Bell Summer Enrichment Program.

Check List:

Below is a check list of things you should know prior to the first day of summer program.

- All parents/guardians are required to fill out a program application for participation in the summer program.
- All children are required to wear a mask while they are on campus. It is suggested that you provide your child with a mask.
- All children must be tested through the LAUSD system and provide proof of negative test results.
- All children will be asked a set of screening questions prior to entering the program on a daily basis.
- Meals will be provided for children attending the summer program. Children may bring their own food if they so choose.
- Children in TK and Kindergarten must be currently enrolled in a LAUSD school.

- Mi hijo está inscrito en LAUSD y en un grado de TK al 8°.

- Entiendo que se da prioridad a los estudiantes que necesitan el programa de 8:00 a.m. a 6:00 p.m., de lunes a viernes.

- Mi hijo ha sido instruido por mí para ir directamente al área supervisada mientras participa en este programa.
- Mi hijo ha sido informado e instruido por mí que no puede dejar el programa a menos que estén firmados por mí o un adulto autorizado. Entiendo que una vez que mi hijo haya salido del programa, no puede regrese por el resto del día.
- Entiendo que si mi hijo no es recogido por un adulto autorizado antes de la hora de cierre de las 6:00 p.m., el personal iniciará procedimientos para niños tardíos: al final de una hora de intentos fallidos de contactar y reunir al niño con el padre/designado, se contactará a una agencia de servicios de protección infantil para asumir la responsabilidad de la supervisión y seguridad del niño.
- Entiendo que la participación en este programa es un privilegio y el incumplimiento por parte de mi hijo de todas las reglas puede resultar en la pérdida de este privilegio.
- He proporcionado más de un número de contacto y los nombres de adultos adicionales que están autorizados a recoger a mi hijo en caso de una emergencia, o que se contactará en caso de que se inicien procedimientos niños tardíos. Middle School Early Release Policy Form

State Legislation governing after school programs for middle schools funded by After School Education and Safety Program and/or 21st Century Community Learning Centers mandates that such programs must operate from the close of school every school day until 6:00 p.m. Programs in schools that dismiss students after 3:00 p.m. must operate a minimum of 3 hours per day. The Los Angeles Unified School District requires a completed Early Release Policy form signed and dated by an authorized adult for any student released before 5:45 p.m. It is expected that middle school students attend 5 days a week and stay for the full duration of the program. In the event that a student is participating in other extracurricular activities during program hours, the parent/guardian or authorized person (18 years or older who is on the student's emergency card) may pick up his/her child or may authorize the child to sign out of the program under the following conditions:

A: Attending a parallel program (program in the school or community such as intervention programs, soccer, basketball, music lessons, religious education, etc.) as long as an agreement with the parent or guardian exists making this the child's enrichment component.
