Hello Parents!

I am Mrs. Kirch – the DOTS teacher at Eagle Rock High School. I provide transition services to students ages 14 and over who have an IEP. Some of these services include:

- ✦ Providing transition assessment and instruction – ask your child about the DOTS 22-23 Schoology course,
- ✦ Assisting students with post-secondary planning - college, work, military, vocational training,
- ✦ Making connections to outside agencies – Regional Center, Department of Rehabilitation, colleges, military programs, Career and Transition Centers (CTCs), other job resource agencies,
- ✦ Mentoring students in work based learning programs:
 - Workability (WAI) – students work at jobs in the community, receive a paycheck, and receive the support and guidance from both me and the supervisor on the job.
 - Transition Partnership Program (TPP) – a partnership program between LAUSD and Department of Rehabilitation (DOR). Activities/lessons fall under the following topics:
 - * Job Exploration
 - * Post-secondary Education and Employment
 - * Work-based Learning Experiences
 - * Workplace Readiness
 - * Self-Advocacy
