

PARTICIPANT REMINDERS

- Check-in time is at 7:30 a.m. on Friday, June 14th. Check-in area will be outside of the Yosemite gate and buses will be lined up of off Yosemite Drive. You will need your ID and receipt (photo on phone is acceptable).
- Buses will depart ERHS at 9:00 a.m. sharp.
- Download the Remind App on your cell phone. Your chaperone will use this app to communicate with you throughout the event. It is required that you respond in a timely manner. In addition, use this app to reach your chaperone, if needed.
- Bring a power bank/source with charging cable fit for your phone as you will need access to your phone for about 19 hours.
- Participant's backpack is subject to a search prior to leaving the high school, and at any time thereafter. The participant may be subject to a pat down search by Disney while on the premises of the Disney Resort.
- Participant is responsible for their own food while at the event. Factory sealed food and drinks are permitted. NO GLASS containers. Refillable water bottles are encouraged.
- Participant medication (including but not limited to inhalers and over-the-counter and prescription medications) need to be in a zipped/closed plastic bag labeled with the participant's name.
- None of the following are allowed: alcoholic beverages, smoking marijuana including marijuana enriched products, medicinal marijuana, vaping devices, or any illegal substances that are prohibited at the Disney Resort. If such items are found on participant, participant is automatically expelled from event with no refund.
- Participant must remain on Disney property at all times.
- YOU MUST KEEP YOUR GRAD NITE TICKET FOR THE DURATION OF THE EVENT AND KEEP YOUR EVENT WRISTBAND ON. WITH THAT BEING SAID, WE RECOMMEND WRITING YOUR NAME ON THE TICKET AS A DIFFERENTIATOR DURING GRAD NITE.
- If participant loses wristband and/or ticket, contact your assigned chaperone immediately. Please note, participant may be sent home, with parent/guardian/authorized person picking up participant from the Disney Park. If participant leaves the Disney property at any time, participant will be automatically expelled, and parent/guardian must immediately pick up participant from the park. No refund will be issued.
- Grad Nite Celebration begins at 9:00 p.m. in Disney California Adventure. Once the celebration begins and you are in Disney California Adventure, park-hopping is no longer available.
- Those needing lockers are encouraged to rent them from the main entrance esplanade or inside Disney California adventure park as attendees will not have access to lockers inside Disneyland Park during or after their private party.
- At 1:00 a.m., start wrapping up your festivities and make your way towards the exit. Please exit right out of the Disney California Adventure Park gates and look for your chaperone. They will have a paddle with your bus number. Once you have checked in with them, make your way towards East Esplanade and board the shuttles to the Toy Story parking area to locate your bus/vehicle.
- Once our buses depart the Disney property, text your parent/guardian the approximate arrival time to ERHS so
 they are there waiting for your arrival. This will help us tremendously with ensuring all our participants go home
 in a timely manner.
- Participants are not allowed to walk home or take public transportation.
