Dear Parents and Guardians,

Service as Action is a requirement of the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (IB MYP). In the IB MYP, service is defined as, “caring members of the community who demonstrate a personal commitment to service, and act to make a positive difference to the lives of others and to the environment.” Performing service offers students learning opportunities outside the classroom, as well as an opportunity to learn about themselves and their community.

Students may perform their service alone or in a group; however, the Reflection Form (summary, reflections & evidence section) must be completed individually. All students need to meet the 7 IB Service-Learning Outcomes upon completion of the 10th grade.

The 7 outcomes are:

- **Awareness** - become more aware of strengths and areas for growth
- **Global Value** - develop international-mindedness through global engagement, multilingualism, and intercultural understanding
- **Perseverance** – maintain course of action
- **Ethics** -reflect on moral implications of actions.
- **Collaboration** - work jointly with others
- **Initiate** - discuss, evaluate, and plan student-initiated activities
- **Challenges & New Skills** - undertake challenges that develop new skills

While we will still require all MYP students to complete this requirement, we will be flexible in how this looks for students. We have every confidence that educators will guide your students in making their best endeavors to meet service requirements with modifications so as not to compromise their health and safety.
