



Quick Guide to Become a Virtual or On-Campus Volunteer in Los Angeles Unified

Parent and community volunteers are an integral part of the learning community in the Los Angeles Unified School District. They provide specialized skills and expertise, school support, and enrich a student's learning environment.

STEP 1

Fill out an application to volunteer at <https://volunteerapp.lausd.net/>. Select whether you would like to serve as a **Virtual** or **On-Campus** volunteer, and select a location where you would like to serve.

STEP 2

ON-CAMPUS VOLUNTEERS

- Contact the site to notify them that you have completed your application.
- Have your valid Tuberculosis (TB) clearance verification available.
- Upload your COVID-19 vaccination card to the Daily Pass <https://dailypass.lausd.net/>.

VIRTUAL VOLUNTEERS

- Contact the site to notify them that you have completed your application.

STEP 3

The principal or site administrator will review the application and will approve based on need.

STEP 4

Once you have uploaded your COVID-19 vaccination information in the Daily Pass, <https://dailypass.lausd.net/> the Community Engagement team will review it thoroughly. If there are any issues with your upload or if it has been approved, you will receive an email communication from the team.

STEP 5

If the application is approved, the Office of Student, Family, and Community Engagement will conduct a final review of the application and confirm approval.

STEP 6

ON-CAMPUS VOLUNTEERS

- After the Office of Student, Family, and Community Engagement approves your application, you will receive a temporary badge through email.

VIRTUAL VOLUNTEERS

- Opportunities to volunteer virtually are provided on an as-needed basis as identified by school administrators.
