Surma Tribe:

- prominent scarification, often women to be beautiful
- toleration of pain when scarification is occurring & using herbs to break children
- scarifications are a beauty sign in their tribes, men are more skin on their
- scarification causes an interesting specific pattern on their

Karayu Tribe:

- every eight years under the full moon, the Karayu plants begin
- scar their cheeks to resemble caps
- scarification with razors & thorns

- face painting + vivid colors
- considered beautiful

Karo Tribe:

- Decorate their bodies w/ chalk, iron ore, + charcoal
- Women inflict lacerations + cuts, on stomachs, chests, or backs to produce intricate patterns
- Men scarify for courageous acts, the scars represent a kill and warriors w/ red ochre clay w/ ostrich feathers

Karayu Tribe:

- scarification done by razors or sharp thorns
- irritate their wounds to make more prominent scars

Kenyan Tribes:

- extensive use of colored jewelry
- the more jewelry one wears, the higher in rank you are



Maasai Tribe:

- use loads of beaded jewelry placed around the neck & arms
- both men & women wear metal hoops on their stretched earlobes

- careful making of beadwork
- many use of bright colors



- wearing heavy earrings to elongate ears
- the longer the earlobes the more "beautiful"

Tribes From Kenya:

- intricate face painting and distinct dresses
- headresses from animal skins & feathers
- tie jewelry everywhere & shaved heads



- traditionally dressed in animal skins which consist of red sheets

- either walk barefoot or with simple sandals

 • The use of mud comes from legends that basically lead them to victory
 • Use long "claws" and masks to pass as ghosts to scare their enemies
